What does CPA mean?

CPA is the short version of **chartered professional accountant**. CPAs do much more than crunch numbers! They are pros who excel in leading, analyzing, and strategizing for the future.

Their expertise is a good fit for key positions in a wide range of sectors.

To be a CPA, you don't have to be a math whiz (phew!)



CPAs interpret numbers to come up with business strategies. In their daily work, CPAs mostly use basic math skills like addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Basically, comprehension and logic are more important than getting an A+ on your algebra exam.

All organizations need accounting professionals if they want to succeed. With the CPA profession, you can choose your employer based on your interests and pastimes. Here are some examples:





These are the steps in the process of obtaining the CPA designation.



Obtain a secondary school diploma. Some CEGEPs require you to pass Secondary 5 mathematics courses in one of the following sequences:

- Technical Science (TS)
- Natural Sciences (NS)

Enroll in a CEGEP and obtain a diploma of college studies from one of these programs:

- Pre-university program
 - Natural sciences
 - Social sciences, with mathematics
- Technology program
 - Accounting and management



Enroll in a recognized bachelor's degree program in accounting or business administration, with a concentration in professional accounting.

Pass the CPA Professional Education Program.
