

## GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN ACCOUNTING

National recognition standards have been established by CPA Canada for courses or a set of university courses that develop the competencies required by the CPA Competency Map and cover specific subject areas. The CPA Order worked in collaboration with the universities to establish a list of compulsory prerequisite courses that meet the national requirements, which are now included in the undergraduate program recognized by the government.


McGill University students are required to pass at a minimum all of the prerequisite courses listed below. The university program comprises additional courses included in the 90 credit structure leading to the undergraduate degree.

## CAVEAT

The general rules for admission to the PEP require a minimum grade point average of $2.8 / 4.3$ or equivalent in the undergraduate program. However, universities may require a higher average or an overall average in the undergraduate program prerequisite courses for admission to a graduatelevel PEP. McGill requires a passing grade of $65 \%$ for each course and a minimum CGPA of 3.0/4.0.
