

"PRO sensations fortes" contest rules

Subject to applicable legislation in Quebec, these rules govern all aspects of the "PRO sensations fortes" contest and are binding upon the parties, i.e. the Quebec CPA Order (hereinafter "the Order") and contest participants.

1. CONTEST PERIOD

The contest period begins on March 23, 2015 and ends on May 4, 2015 (11:59 p.m., EAST).

2. HOW TO ENTER

Persons wishing to take part in the contest must visit the Order's "Devenir CPA" Facebook page (facebook.com/devenirCPA) during the contest period and follow the procedure under the "Concours/Contest" tab. Note that participants must choose between the three prizes, based on their fields of interest, and may not check more than one option or win more than one prize.

Entry forms must be submitted before the dates listed in the table below. All entries received after the dates shown in the "Contest end date" column are ineligible and will be automatically set aside.

A limit of one entry per person is allowed during the contest period. Participants may use only one email address to enter the contest, even if they have more than one. The odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received.

No purchase is required to enter the contest.

The Order will accept no liability for lost, erroneous, fraudulent or late entry forms.

3. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

The contest is open to Quebec residents who are 18 years of age and older. Participants must also be enrolled for the winter 2015 term in an undergraduate program related to accounting at one of the following universities:

- John Molson School of Business at Concordia University;
- École des sciences de la gestion of the Université du Québec à Montréal;
- McGill University's Desautels Faculty of Management;
- HEC Montréal;
- Bishop's University;

- Université de Sherbrooke;
- Université du Québec en Abitibi-Témiscamingue;
- Université du Québec à Chicoutimi;
- Université du Québec en Outaouais;
- Université du Québec à Rimouski;
- Université du Québec à Trois-Rivières;
- Université Laval.

Staff members of the Order and the persons with whom they are domiciled are not eligible to enter the contest. The Order's members and candidates for the profession registered with the Order are also excluded from the contest.

4. DESCRIPTION OF THE PRIZES

→ SKYVENTURE:

Package - 4 flights for 2 people

The prize is valued at \$187 and includes:

- A package of 4 flights for 2 people (8 in total), equal to the free fall portion of 4 parachute jumps. Training, warm-up, equipment and instructor are included in this activity.
- The activity lasts around 2 hours and 30 minutes.

The winner will invite one person of his or her choice (here in after "guest"). The guest must also be a Quebec resident who is 18 years of age or older.

→ MAEVA SURF:

Package – Rental of the entire wave

The prize is valued at \$550 and includes:

- Rental of the entire wave for 1 to 16 people. This package includes registration, training, two seasoned instructors, the surfboards and 1 hour of indoor surfing for the group.
- The total activity lasts around 2 hours.

The winner can choose to go alone or bring a maximum of 15 guests.

→ DÉCALADE:

Package - 3 forward rappelling descents for 2 people

The prize is valued at \$198 and includes:

- Forward rappelling descents for 2 people (3 descents per person). This package also includes the safety equipment, training and individual coaching.
- The entire activity lasts around 3 hours.

Exclusions:

One prize may be won per participant and that prize must be decided in advance when the participant registers for the contest. All expenses that are not specifically mentioned in the above description, including travel costs, meals and beverages, taxes, insurance and personal expenses are the sole responsibility of the winner.

In the event that the Order is unable to award one of the prizes described in these rules for reasons not related to the winner, it reserves the right to award a prize of equivalent kind and value or, at its sole discretion, the cash value of the prize indicated in these rules.

5. DRAW

The three prizes will be awarded at random in an electronic draw from among all eligible entry forms received through the Order's "Devenir CPA" Facebook page during the contest period.

The winners of the prizes will be contacted by telephone or by email within a maximum of 5 business days of the draw dates. If the winners cannot be reached within that period of time, their rights to the prizes will be forfeited and the prize will be awarded to another participant based on the same random draw procedure.

The winner will receive instructions on how to claim the prize by telephone.

6. CLAIMING THE PRIZES

The winners may claim their prize in person at the office of the Order during office hours or ask to receive the gift card in the mail. The winners must take possession of their prize within a maximum of 30 days of being reached by telephone or by email, unless exceptional circumstances apply or the parties agree otherwise.

The prizes may only be claimed by persons entered in the contest, who will release the Order from any liability, especially with respect to damages or losses arising from participation in the contest, or from the awarding or use of the prize. The winners must use the prizes by or on the dates indicated in the table below.

7. GENERAL RULES

The winners authorize the Order to validate their enrollment with the university faculty indicated on the contest entry form. The winners authorize the Order to use their name, photo, university name and any statement made regarding the contest for promotional purposes, without any form of compensation.

Once they have taken possession of their prize, the winners agree to provide a minimum of 15 photos of themselves, as indicated in the table below, which have been taken in a setting directly related to the prize they received from the Order. The winners consent to the use of their photos for promotional purposes on the Order's website, in its electronic newsletters, in newspapers or on social media.

Refusal to accept one of the prizes releases the Order from any and all responsibilities and obligations towards the winner.

Any false statement made by a participant will result in his or her automatic disqualification from the contest.

The Order reserves the right to end this contest should events beyond its control prevent it from continuing the contest and it is authorized to do so by the Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux. In that event, it will bear no liability.

Participants agree to be bound by these rules and the decisions of the Order, which is conducting this contest, and whose decisions are final and without appeal.

The Order and the persons for whose benefit this contest is being held will accept no liability whatsoever in any event where their inability to act is the result of an event or circumstance that is beyond their control, or of a strike, lock-out or any other labour dispute at the places of business of organizations or firms whose services are used in conjunction with this contest.

The French and English versions of these rules can be found on the Order's Web site at cpaquebec.ca/contests. In the event of a dispute, the French version will prevail over the English.

Any litigation respecting the conduct or organization of a publicity contest may be submitted to the Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux for a ruling. A litigation respecting the awarding of a prize may be submitted to the Régie only for the purpose of helping the parties reach a settlement.

Participants authorize the Quebec CPA Order to use their identity information to communicate with them regarding the CPA profession.
